### Regional Railroads

- Only other connection to Long Island is via Selkirk, 160 miles to the North
- Interchange service in NY between NYNJR and New York and Atlantic (NYA)
- Only significant new capacity being built to provide additional, competitive rail access to points East of Hudson










  - Grade Crossings Within the Yard
  - Utility Work
















\*\*For the sixth year in a row, the intersection of I-95 and SR 4 in Fort Lee, New Jersey is once again the Number One freight bottleneck in the country. American Transportation Research Industry (ATRI).

#### **Proven Success – Virginia Model**

#### **Blue Highway Project**

- Since 2017, the port has **increased** container **moves by barge** by **67%**.
- Each barge trip saves more than 10,000 truck miles on Virginia's highways.
- Using barges results in 35% less NOx and 60% less CO2 emissions as compared to moving freight by truck.
- **Saved** well over **700,000 truck trips** since the service started.


