
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS: PILOT SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT MORRIS COUNTY TRAIL CROSSINGS **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Responses to Questions, issued on January 8, 2026

Question 1: On pages 3-4 of the RFP, under “Task 2: Surveying/Base Mapping (10%),” the RFP states, “In general, the survey shall extend 200 feet past the project limits in each direction.” Please clarify what is meant by “each direction.” Does this apply only to survey along the roadway or along the trail as well?

Response 1: Survey shall extend 200 feet along the roadway in each direction.

Question 2: On page 4 of the RFP, under “Task 3: Preliminary Engineering (30%),” the RFP states, “A solar assessment report needs to be performed for all locations where solar panels are proposed.” Please clarify what is included as part of a “solar assessment report.” Can an example solar assessment report be provided?

Response 2: Consultant will need to assess each location where solar powered RRFBs are being proposed to determine effectiveness and suitability of solar panels including available solar irradiance data.

Question 3: Given the scope of the improvements span 16 different municipalities in Morris County, how many Local Officials/Stakeholder meeting and Public Information Centers does NJTPA/Morris County anticipate during the Preliminary Engineering Phase and during the Final Design Phase?

Response 3: The County will discuss the project with Local Officials for each municipality. A presentation is not anticipated. One virtual PIC meeting will be held for the entire project.
