




PROJECTED COST: \$1,000,000

LOCATION: Brick Township

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This study will explore options for improving safety at Brick Boulevard (County Route 631) and Hooper Avenue (CR 11), and Brick Boulevard and Chambers Bridge Road (CR 549), in Brick Township. Ocean County applied to the NJTPA's Fiscal Year 2026 Local Concept Development Program, the first phase in the Local Capital Project Delivery Program, for funding.

ABOUT THE PROJECT AREA: These roads experience heavy traffic, frequent crashes, and challenges for people walking and biking. The project area is a busy triangular corridor where high traffic volumes, numerous driveways, and wide



intersections lead to congestion and elevated crash rates. Growth in Brick Township and nearby Lakewood Township has increased pressure on these roads, while seasonal beach traffic adds to delays. These issues affect daily travel and overall safety. By examining options such as better lane layouts, upgraded signals, safer access points, and pedestrian and bicycle improvements, the study will recommend solutions that make travel safer and more efficient for everyone.

THE LOCAL CAPITAL PROJECT DELIVERY

PROGRAM: The NJTPA's Local Capital Project Delivery Program awards grants to counties and cities to investigate all aspects of a project including environmental, right of way access, design and feasibility issues. Projects that complete this initial investigative work, called the Local Concept Development Phase, may be eligible for eventual construction with federal funds.
