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**Responses to Questions, issued on February 25, 2026**

**Question 1:** Please confirm the submission deadline.

**Response 1:** The deadline for inquiries is February 19, and the deadline for proposals is March 11, 2026 at 2:00 PM (ET).

**Question 2:** If known, when is this project expected to go to bid for contractors and what is the expected start date for construction?

**Response 2:** The production of construction documents is not within the scope of work of this RFP.

**Responses to Questions raised at the February 12, 2026 Pre-proposal Meeting, issued on February 25, 2026**

A pre-proposal meeting was held by virtual meeting on February 12, 2026, to provide a general overview of the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the FY 2026-27 Subregional Assistance with Studies and Analyses. The following are questions asked by meeting attendees and the NJTPA's official responses.

**Question 3:** Is there a page limit for the technical approach, and is there a limit to the number of resumes that can be submitted?

**Response 3:** No. There is no page limit to the technical approach. There is no limit to the number of resumes that can be submitted. The technical proposal must include the resumes of the key personnel who would be assigned to the project. However, it is not necessary to include the resume of all staff listed on the Resources Plan Table.

**Question 4:** With regard to the project budget, does this project appear in the UPWP as "FY 2027 SASA" (\$300K)?

**Response 4:** In the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for FY 2027, the proposed budget is to add funding to this project for Task 2. There will be a contract modification to add these funds to the current project that is described in our FY 2026 UPWP.

**Question 5:** Is it anticipated that NJTPA and/or subregions will handle any local outreach?

**Response 5:** Subregions may be conducting outreach to local officials during this effort to discuss potential safety improvements. Consultant involvement in outreach will be limited to providing requested data and proposed conceptual layouts as needed.

**Question 6:** With the contract mod for \$300, in year two...what is the first year budget? \$1.7M?

**Response 6:** The project budget will not be treated as separate annual budgets. The additional funds will be added to the total contract budget for the project.
